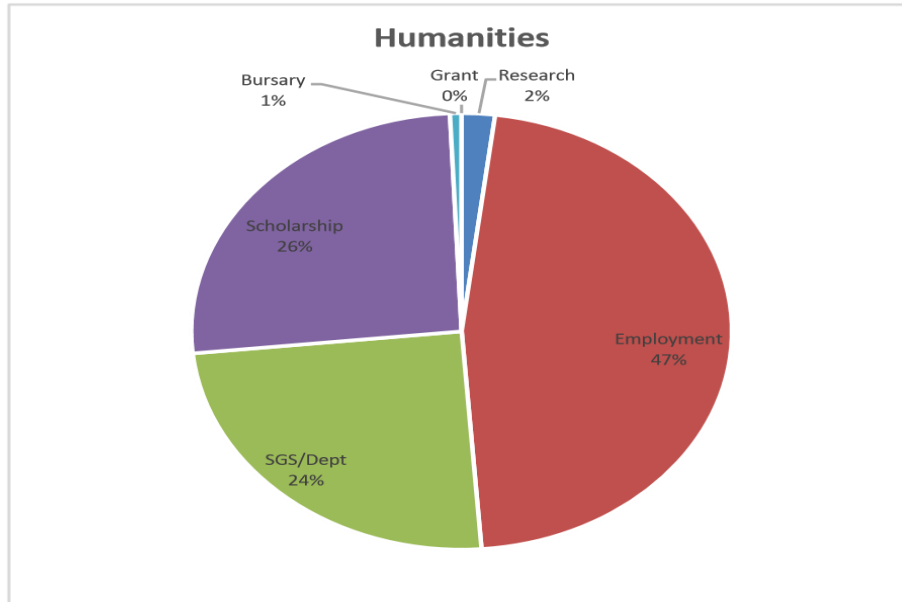

Employment

TA/RA – Most graduate students receive a two-term TA/RA. 130 hrs/term, 260 hours total. Departments determine, based on projected enrolments, separate from SGS.

Scholarship

Tri-Council/OGS are dominant – 85-90% of total.

SGS/Dept

Graduate scholarship allocation supplemented by Faculty operating budget.
